Recycle Runway Exhibition Sponsorship Opportunities

>> Levels of Sponsorship

The Recycle Runway Exhibit will be installed in eight cases located throughout International Concourse E on either side of the restrooms down the length of the Concourse (see terminal map). Each case will feature Recycle Runway garments and will have a specific environmental message. Sponsorship levels are based upon the location and focus of each case. Below are descriptions of the various levels of sponsorship. *Ms. Judd is happy to adapt these sponsorships to meet your marketing goals!*

Cases 1 and 2 - \$25,000 each

Case 1 (7 feet long) is located next to Gate E27. Case 2 (8 feet long) is located across from Gate E11. Both of these cases are positioned in a high traffic area near the food court and will display one or two garments each. Sponsorship benefits include:

- Choice of environmental message and specific garment(s) displayed in the case
- Exclusive sponsorship of the case(s) you sponsor
- Four-inch logo and 50-word description of your environmental initiatives on a placard prominently located in the case
- Your name on a take-away exhibition brochure located next to the cases

Cases 3 and 4 - \$20,000 each

Case 3 (15 feet long) is located next to Gate E27. Case 4 (11 feet long) is located next to Gate E9. These are the largest cases in the exhibition. They will contain three garments each and are located in a high traffic area near the food court. Sponsorship benefits include:
