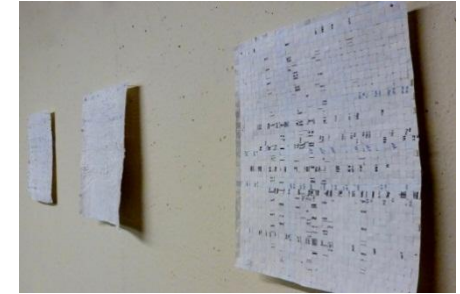


## Deconstruction/reconstruction



Recycling saves lots of energy, raw material and water. It is a process that consist on remanufacture a product from an unwanted or used product. In UWC-USA since all the tools to recycle are given, a way to show this process as a metaphor I used different unwanted products such as lint from dryer machines, shredded paper and pencil shaving to create the original product out of it. It is shown a new created product while it can still be seen the unwaned material used. That way the process of recycling, which is in the middle of the unwanted material and the new product reconstructed, is motivated and ecaurege people to recycle.

The objects created were three shits of paper from the weaving of shredded white paper. Also there were five pencils made out of variuous pencil shaving with glue. And finally a hat cerated from the lindt of the dryer machines.
